Funding Restrictions and timeline:

Grants must be submitted by Monday, May 22. The Committee will review grant applications during the month of June and meet to make decisions in July. Grant awards will be announced by August 15, 2019.

Grantees must:

- Be either an educational non-profit organization, public school educational institution or Parent/Teacher Association.
- Be located in or serving children from zip codes associated with Glen Park neighborhood (94110, 94112, 94127, 94131.)
- Serve low income populations as evidenced by children receiving free/reduced lunches, scholarships, etc.
- Be for discrete projects/programs/capital outlays/teacher or aide salaries--grants to fund tuition/scholarships are not applicable.

Funding Guidelines:

- Educational or community building focus
- Grantees will be given preference if they have participated in current year Festival. Great volunteer project for kids!!!!
- A simple report must be completed by February 28, 2018 to be considered for funding again.
- Money must be spent by February 28, 2018 unless otherwise approved. If you have trouble spending the money before this date, please advise us of revised plan. You will need to do this to be considered for next round of funding. Funds not spent in 24 months must be returned.
- Applications are due Monday, May 22, 2017
